We are delighted to report that St Clare's, Oxford has performed outstandingly well in this year's [Times newspaper league table](#) of UK state and independent schools' A Level and IB results.

According to the league table, St Clare's has outperformed local rivals such as Oxford High School, Headington, D'Overbroeck's and St Edward's, and nationally is placed above famous names like Westminster School, City of London and North London Collegiate School.

St Clare's is in 12th position nationally based on the percentage of scores of 7 and 6 in Higher Level IB subjects, which are the equivalent of A* and A at A Level.

Among UK independent schools, St Clare's is in the top ten (in 8th place). We have been successfully offering the IB for over 40 years and will continue welcoming young people from a wide variety of backgrounds and from more than 40 countries world-wide.

Dear Parents,

The government's official Performance Tables were released last Thursday. They are based on the examination results of students who sat the IB Diploma or A levels in May 2013 and compare the performance of every school and college in England. I am writing to let you know how well St. Clare's has done.

- St. Clare's has achieved the best sixth form results in Oxfordshire for the 4th year in a row.
- The average points per student increased by 50 points.
- Amongst all secondary schools in England, we are ranked 8th - this includes both state and independent schools. Last year we were ranked 15th so this is a significant improvement.
- We are the only school or college from Oxford which is ranked as a top ten school or college in England.

As you can imagine I was delighted to hear the news. I am continually amazed at the excellent job which we do here at St. Clare's and the positive impact which our work has on the achievement of our students. I felt that everyone could go home feeling justifiably proud of the work which we did last year and which we continue to do year-on-year.

None of this, of course, would be possible without the effort made by the students themselves. It remains a source of real joy to me that they embrace their studies so enthusiastically and appear to genuinely relish the educational opportunities which St. Clare's offers.
